Traffic Engineering Activities – March 2016 through May 2016

A: Projects

- 1: Olympic and Beverly-Beverly intersection - **The consultant is preparing and designing the approved plans.**

B: Ongoing traffic studies and data collection (citywide)

- 1: Conducted a multiple-day parking inventory survey on Canon and adjacent streets.
- 2: Responded to public inquiries about the placement of signs, red curbs, striping, address markings, and traffic counts. Responded to requests for information from the public, traffic citation challenges, records subpoenas, expert witness requests, depositions, court appearance requests (most staff time spent on this task), complaints about traffic congestion and speeding, school area traffic/parking management inquiries, and other traffic engineering issues (including Web-CBH Transportation public inquiries and citywide Comcate generated public inquiries). **Ongoing.**
- 3: Submitted **31** work orders to the Public Works Services Department that included placing or relocating traffic and parking signs, street markings, curb markings, striping plans, and meter heads/posts; signal timing adjustments; and coordination timing and signal pole replacements. Below is a summary list of work orders that were issued for the last 3 months. Please refer to the last page.

4: Speed humps applications in process:

- 300 S. Linden Dr. Pending signatures of adjacent resident(s)-**A status letter was sent to all residents.**
- San Ysidro Dr. (north of Tower) - Pending the final approval of one adjacent resident.
- 100 N. Le Doux Rd. Field evaluation completed. Pending signatures of adjacent residents. **Adjustments were made to relocate one of the speed humps to receive consent from the adjacent resident.**
- 400 S. Clark Dr. Pending signatures of adjacent residents. **No new activity.**
- Smithwood Dr. Field evaluation completed – Pending submission the consent of adjacent residents. **No new activity.**
- Tower Rd. (north of San Ysido) - Petition has been received. **A field meeting was held with the petitioner and two other residents to evaluate alternative locations to place speed humps. A form was mailed to receive adjacent resident's consent.**
- **400 Peck Drive. A petition was received and signed by residents – Pending staff evaluation.**

C: Private Development Transportation Reviews

1: Continued the review process for Traffic Impact Reports, Environmental Impact Reports and other circulation issues of new developments:

- Review of traffic impact study/ draft EIR of the proposed development in Los Angeles at 333 N. La Cienega Boulevard.
- Reviewed City of LA WLA TIMP draft IER and provided comments.
- Reviewed circulation analysis of the new proposed hotel as a part of the 9900 Wilshire Boulevard project and provided comments revising the driveways.
- Review of traffic circulation study of the proposed car rental at 264 S. La Cienega.
- Reviewed the circulation of improvements at the auto dealership site at 9031 Olympic.
- Review of the traffic studies of 9900 Wilshire project and discussed corrections of Level of Service analysis. No further activity.

2: Reviewed over **35** traffic plan applications for public right-of-way permits in cooperation with the City's Permit Center. Traffic plans are required to be prepared by applicants for temporary closure of traffic lane(s), generally for the following purposes:

- Delivery of construction equipment and materials; temporary use of metered spaces for special events; and utility repairs/replacements by *Edison*, phone companies and other utility companies.
- **AT&T projects - reviewed 5 locations.**

- *Southern California Edison* construction sites citywide - **45 locations.**
 - *Metro* La Cienega subway station utilities relocation of water, sewer, *SCE* and storm drain - biweekly coordination meeting with the *Metro* and LADOT - attended 1 meeting.
 - *Metro* La Cienega subway station - construction detour alternatives traffic study - coordination with *Metro* and LADOT - No activity.
- 3: Reviewed construction-related transportation issues for projects presently under construction:
- Construction of new hotel (*Waldorf Astoria*) signal improvements at Wilshire Blvd./N. Santa Monica Blvd., Merv Griffin Way/Santa Monica Blvd., **Reviewed traffic plans for work relating to off-site improvements at Wilshire and N. Santa Monica- Wilshire side.**

D: Out of Ordinary

- 1: Citywide Striping longevity study. With the cooperation of the Street Maintenance Division, staff is conducting an evaluation of the life of pavement markings (striping, stop legends, etc.) and labor hours and equipment needs. This study will be used to schedule frequencies of re-striping and pavement markings within the city.
- 2: For the last month, staff has been involved in depositions and court appearances in cases involving the City of Beverly Hills. A number of hours have been spent collecting records, production and preparation meetings with the City Attorney and Risk Management Division.
