SUBJECT: Refuse container and label replacement project

This memorandum serves as an update on staff's proposed refuse container replacement project. While the project has yet to be finalized, the following describes the general approach envisioned by staff.

Staff is aware of the Commission's suggestion to replace current bin labels with new (Recycle: We Do It For You) labels. Staff plans to replace all of the affected containers with a colored mold in graphic (Recycle: We Do It For You) label.
