



SUBJECT: FORMER COLDWATER/CABRILLO RESERVOIR SITE REHABILITATION PROJECT

The Mayor has been working with the Chair and Vice Chair of both the Public Works and Planning Commissions, along with designated staff, to discuss the City's infrastructure needs and costs in order to create a coordinated vision for the next ten years. The process includes reviewing current projects identified in the Capital Improvement Program ("CIP"), projects that are not fully funded, as well as a "Wish List" of less defined projects.

One project that is currently not planned but is being discussed and considered (in concept) by the Infrastructure Committee is to expand the City's emergency water storage capacity by constructing reservoirs on the former Coldwater/Cabrillo site. Staff is currently working to develop conceptual cost estimates for the Infrastructure Committee to review at their next meeting scheduled for September 2015.

The Public Works Commission Chair and Vice Chair will provide additional information during the August 11, 2015, Commission meeting.
