SUBJECT: UPDATE ON COMMUNITY CHOICE AGGREGATION

At its April 21, 2015, the City Council adopted Resolution 15-R-13035, authorizing the City to participate in a feasibility study related to Community Choice Aggregation. This feasibility study is currently underway, led by the County of Los Angeles's County's Office of Sustainability. In order to complete this work, the County must first have energy usage data from Southern California Edison ("SCE") for all participating cities in Los Angeles County in SCE's service territory. The County has received a portion of this data at this point and anticipates receiving the rest of the data in the coming months. At this point, the County anticipates that the Feasibility Study will be completed in late spring 2016. This schedule could change depending on the availability of data from SCE.

The City also continues to participate in the South Bay Clean Power Working Group, which is providing recommendations to the County of Los Angeles as the feasibility study moves forward.

Staff will continue to provide updates to the Public Works Commission as the project moves forward.
