The Adjourned Regular City Council meeting was held in the Wallis Annenberg Center for the Performing Arts Bram Goldsmith Theater at 7:00 pm.

***B. MATTERS PRESENTED BY COUNCILMEMBERS***

1. CITY COUNCIL REORGANIZATION, INCLUDING ELECTION AND INSTALLATION OF MAYOR AND VICE MAYOR.

Mayor Mirisch acknowledged the dignitaries, electeds, and officials in attendance at tonight's meeting.

Mayor Mirisch gave his parting remarks as Mayor for the past year, highlighting the initiatives he has introduced and worked on during the past year such as the Southeast Task Force, the Mayor's Sunshine Task Force, and the historical preservation program. He also spoke about the challenges California cities face and the City Council needs to continue working on such as reforming the public employee pay and pension structure, reducing unfunded liabilities, working to give residents and taxpayers the best value for the money, making the City more bicycle- and pedestrian-friendly, and bringing the "green of our garden city into the metaphysical space of our lifestyles." He thanked his City Council colleagues, City Treasurer Finkel, Vice Mayor Bosse's mom Rose Toren, Marilyn Gallup, Isabel Hacker, his supporters and friends, City staff, the Annenberg, and family including his mother Wendy Goldberg, brother Richard and sister Amanda, Cassia and son Vin.

A video reviewing his year as Mayor was shown.

Vice Mayor Bosse presented outgoing Mayor Mirisch with a gift and plaque, and proclamations from U.S. Senator Barbara Boxer, U.S. Senator Dianne Feinstein, and U.S. Representative Henry Waxman. She thanked him for being creative and an innovative voice for change, and bringing fresh ideas to the City.

***ITEM B-1: LILI BOSSE ELECTED AND INSTALLED AS MAYOR***

Outgoing Mayor Mirisch invited the Bosse family to come up to the stage and Sidney Poitier to administer the oath of office for Ms. Bosse.

Retiring Mayor Mirisch presented Mayor Bosse with a scroll and new gavel.

Mayor Bosse delivered her acceptance remarks, thanking Mr. Poitier, the Beverly Hills Clergy for the invocation, and her husband Jon and sons Andrew and Adam, mom Rose Toren and mother-in-law Selma Bosse. She praised the men and women who dedicated their time to public service as Mayors and Councilmembers. She called onstage former Mayors Donna Ellman Garber, Vicki Reynolds Pepper, Meralee Goldman, Linda Briskman, and Nancy Krasne, and thanked them for their commitment, leadership, and paving the way for her and other women Mayors to follow.

Mayor Bosse spoke about the programs under her "healthy people – healthy economy – healthy government city initiative" which include the "Walk with the Mayor" program every

Monday morning at 8:30am and the "Sixty Second Shout Out" program to businesses in Beverly Hills – with Geary's of Beverly Hills as the first sixty second shout out recipient. She acknowledged President and CEO Tom Blumenthal, and thanked Geary's for their baccarat chandelier donation to the 2014 holiday décor program.

She also welcomed several new local businesses, and pledged to continue efforts toward the goal of budget sustainability.

Mayor Bosse announced her "Text BH" program under her "healthy city initiative" with a new City phone number (310) 596-4265 to text in service requests, questions and comments to the City.

A video about Mayor Bosse's initiatives was presented.

After a musical number by the Beverly Hills High School (BHHS) Marching Band, Mayor Bosse thanked BHHS Instrumental Music Teacher Bill Bradbury and the BHHS Marching Band, and welcomed Chris Mann, star of the PBS concert series "A Mann for all Seasons" and "The Voice," who sang "You Raise Me Up" and "Roads."


