1. Requests by Beverly Hills School District Regarding Construction at Horace Mann Elementary School Including Waiving the Parking Meter Fees Along the East Side of Robertson Boulevard
Staff will present the School District's requests that impact the public right of way due to the proposed construction at Horace Mann Elementary School.

Civil Engineer Samer Elayyan discussed the Beverly Hills Unified School District's (BHUSD) request to waive parking meter fees, public right-of-way use fees, and sidewalk closure while Horace Mann Elementary School is under construction. He provided an overview of the construction and proposed schedule.

BHUSD consultant Tim Buresh spoke on behalf of the district.

Council approved waiving the fees and sidewalk closure. They further directed staff to return at a future Study Session with a construction update in six months.

2. Status of Agreement with Phil Savenick's Company, TV is OK Productions, Inc., Regarding 'Beverly Hills: 100 Years, 100 Stories' Video Project
This item reviews the chronology of events regarding a proposed contractual agreement between Mr. Savenick's company and the City.

Marketing and Economic Sustainability Manager Megan Roach provided background on Phil Savenick's Centennial video project, 'Beverly Hills: 100 Years, 100 Stories.'

Mr. Savenick spoke about his video project and provided a history from the time he was authorized by the Council to move forward with the project.

City Attorney Wiener responded to questions regarding intellectual property.

Council indicated that Mr. Savenick's produced material is his property with no funds paid to him. Further, they indicated that a licensing agreement may be entered into between the City and Mr. Savenick at a future date.

3. Request by Councilmembers Brien and Krasne to Consider Limiting Tour Bus Activity on Rodeo Drive between Wilshire Boulevard and North Santa Monica Boulevard
Provides a follow-up to the City Council discussion on February 4, 2014 regarding tour bus activity.


