On March 25, 2019, the Health & Safety Commission (the "Commission") voted to recommend to the City Council a ban on the sale of tobacco products. The Commission voted to include two carve outs from this recommendation. One carve out was to allow existing and future hotels to sell tobacco products to hotel guests permanently ("in perpetuity").

Chair Ross has requested that the Commission meet to amend, and/or annul the vote taken on March 25, 2019, relative to the sale of tobacco products at hotels, in order to be consistent with the Chair's comments during the March 25, 2019 meeting. The request is for a Special meeting to be held on April 29 at 3:00 PM for the Commission to consider this issue.
